Teaching Resources Supplement

This could provide support for special classroom or school projects for students. Teachers at all levels are eligible for these funds.

Endowment

This could secure a base from which Garden City Public Schools will benefit in the future.

Special Projects

This is for specific projects of the donor's choice which meet specific criteria. Funds, as specified can be held in discretionary accounts.
